The streets of Kingston are now sweltering with heat of over 90 degrees most days and so we have taken a break from the street ministry with most of our work now in the offices of **Operation Save Jamaica (OSJ)**. There is plenty to do in the office, as we have a very small team and are currently planning a very big conference. In October 2018 OSJ's partner organization – **The Jamaica Christian Diaspora Conference (JCDC)** will be hosting the second Christian Diaspora Conference. As well as participants from the Jamaican diaspora regions (mainly UK, Canada, and US), this year participants will include those from the Caribbean and Africa.



We were delighted to run into Patrick Regan on his visit to **Operation Restoration School (ORCS)** for its annual graduation. ORCS is one of the partner organizations of OSJ working closely together with the students and parents as part of our community work.
