SUNDAYS

SundayAM (During the 10.45 service)

Our 10.45 morning praise service is our informal service. Just before the sermon the young people leave into one of our two groups (10 – 14's & 14 – 18's). There may be games, crafts, dramas or creative prayer activities, which will point towards a Bible message. Our older group has a slightly different feel to it where they will also contribute and be more involved with the wider Church life.



Sunday Club (7.30 – 9pm)

For Years 10 – 13, Sunday Club is our relaxed youth group. Each week varies from a social, a hot topic, to a Bible study. Often there are silly games, we'll catch up on the week gone by, and look at the Christian faith in relevant, and practical ways.



WEDNESDAYS

Craft Café (3.15 – 5pm)

A place to drop in after school for cake, hot drinks, and a different craft each week. The crafts range from spray painting to collage, cake decorating, to stitching. Cost is £2 per week.



Games Night (6 – 7.30pm)

As it says on the tin, an evening packed with a variety of different games from Football to Dodgeball, Ping Pong to Pool! It's a really fun evening open to all.



Strive (6 -7.30pm)

Alternate Wednesdays we have a chance to look deeper into what it means to be a Christian. We start with a cooked dinner, before exploring faith together in fun and creative ways.



FRIDAYS

Friday Club (6 – 7.30pm)

For school years 6 – 9, an action packed 90 minutes to round off the week! With a variety of different evenings from chill nights with games and sports, to different themed nights and activities there is plenty of fun to be had at Friday Club. Don't forget the infamous tuck shop!
